You will make diagnostic determinations and decisions, provide diagnostic/therapeutic interventions, coordinate treatment plans, and stabilize and manage psychiatric emergencies as needed.

- have a solid understanding of principles, theories, and practices of mental health disorders

- Consult with others to discuss treatment plans, new or unusual situations, findings, options, and recommendations on client/patient cases.
- Write, implement, and provide documentation of individual client's treatment; maintain records to comply with federal requirements and write reports indicative of progress or regression.
