Mission

Our dedicated team of professionals ensures public safety by effectively managing offenders while maintaining close collaboration with partner agencies and the community. Our team is devoted to providing maximum opportunities for offenders to make lasting changes through accountability, treatment, education, and positive reinforcement within a safe environment.

Terminology

- Prison/Jail:** Prisons hold people convicted of felony crimes. Jails hold those awaiting trial or sentenced to shorter terms (misdemeanors).
- Probation/Parole:** Forms of community supervision. A probationer is sentenced to community supervision *instead* of prison. Probation sometimes comes *in addition* to jail time. A parolee is supervised in the community *after* their prison time.
- Courts/Board:** After a conviction, the courts sentence a person to serve a time frame (e.g. 0-5 years). The Board of Pardons & Parole decides how much of that time the person will serve. The Board also sets parole conditions for supervision.
- Violation/New Offense:** An offender on probation or parole can return to prison for serious or continued violations of their conditions, or a new crime.
- Correctional Officer:** Professional term for guard.
